



Thinking about stopping smoking?

Preparing to stop smoking is a big decision. You are likely to be having mixed feelings about it. Smoking is a powerful addiction and is therefore not easy to give up.

Making a list of things you like and dislike about smoking, and the reasons why are you thinking about stopping, may make you more confident in your decision to stop.

It is important that you know that your smoking influences those around you. You can be a positive role model by deciding to quit.

Why CAMQUIT?

CAMQUIT is your local NHS Stop Smoking Service. You are more likely to quit smoking successfully with support from NHS Stop Smoking Services and Nicotine Replacement Therapy (NRT) rather than going cold turkey.

Joining an NHS Stop Smoking Programme entitles you to prescription-only charges for NRT and other stop smoking medications. If you don't pay for your prescriptions, NRT and other stop smoking medications will be free.

Don't forget that pharmacies and doctors' surgeries both provide the stop smoking service, making it more accessible for you.

So what can you expect from a stop smoking service?

Your first session will last around 20 minutes, then you will usually have three or four follow-up sessions of around ten minutes each to help you stay on track.

We'll teach you some tips to deal with cravings and support you along the way. We can even help you with your stop smoking medication.
